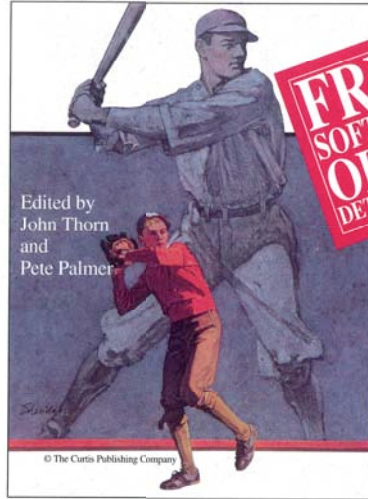

**Getting Started**

**To install on an IBM®-PC/Compatible:**

1. At the prompt, type the letter of the CD-ROM drive followed by a colon. Press Enter.
2. Type SETUP and press Enter. You will be asked which drive and directory you want to install DiscPassage on. Press Enter to accept the default (C:\DISCPASS), or type in a new drive letter, and press Enter. Installation is complete! Type DP and press Enter to view the CD-ROM.
3. Subsequently, to view any DiscPassage disc, type DP at the prompt of the drive where you previously installed DiscPassage and press Enter.
4. To hear Sound Clips on a PC, select Contents from the Menu, then the Sound Clips. Press F9 for the list of audio tracks. Choose the desired sound from this list using the arrow keys, then press Enter. You must have headphones or external speakers connected to the CD-ROM drive to hear the Sound Clips.
5. For further assistance with installation, information on using DiscPassage, or troubleshooting tips, type the letter of the CD-ROM drive, followed by a colon. Press Enter. At the prompt, enter "README" to view further installation instructions. Enter "PRINTME" to print further instructions. To find on-line HELP, press the F1 key.

**To install on a Macintosh®:**

1. Insert the CD-ROM into your CD-ROM drive. Double click on the disc icon *Total Baseball*. A new window will appear with a DiscPassage icon.
2. Drag the DiscPassage icon to the area on your hard drive where you wish to install it. Installation is complete.
3. To start your DiscPassage CD-ROM, double click on its icon, which you installed on your hard drive.
4. To hear Sound Clips on a Macintosh, open the *Total Baseball* database, and choose Sound Clips from the next screen. Pull down the Document Menu and choose the clip you would like to hear. You must have headphones or external speakers connected to the CD-ROM drive to hear the Sound Clips.
5. For further assistance with installation, information on using DiscPassage, or troubleshooting tips, double click on the "AAREAD.1ST" icon. For on-line help while using DiscPassage, click HELP in the File Menu.
