







Adobe Photoshop Elements

Version 2.0 for Mac OS

QUICK REFERENCE CARD



* Tools appear in options bar only.

Toolbar shortcuts

- Press shortcut key (in parentheses) to select tool.
- ⌘ + click tool or ⌘ + press shortcut key to cycle through hidden tools.
- Control + Tab to cycle through open documents.
- Control + click on image to display context-sensitive menu.
- Press Caps Lock to use precise cross hair for brushes.
- Press Return to close a magnetic lasso selection, or press Esc or ⌘ + ⎚ to cancel the operation.
- Press ⇧ to constrain dragging or drawing to straight line or multiples of 45°.

Mac OS X users: When the Use System Shortcut Keys preference is enabled, certain Photoshop keyboard shortcuts are usurped by OS X keyboard shortcuts. (For example, with the preference on, Command + H hides the application. With the preference off, Command + H shows/hides Selection.) To prevent this, press the Control key in addition to the shortcut or choose Photoshop Elements > Preferences > General and deselect Use System Shortcut Keys.

Painting

RESULT	ACTION
Switch to eyedropper tool 	Any painting tool or shape tool +  (except impressionist brush)

Sets opacity, pressure, or exposure for painting mode	Any painting or editing tool + number keys (e.g., 0 = 100%, 1 = 10%, 4 then 5 in quick succession = 45%)
Cycles through blending modes	 +

Brushes pop-up palette

- + click brush deletes brush.
- [or] decreases/increases brush size.
- + [or] decreases/increases brush softness/hardness in 25% increments.
- Control + click brush to select Rename Brush from the context sensitive menu renames brush.

Swatches palette

- Click in empty area of palette creates new swatch from foreground color.
- + click swatch selects background color.
- + click swatch deletes swatch.

Free Transform

- transforms from center.
- constrains to original aspect ratio.
- distorts.
- skews.
- + changes perspective.
- Return or Enter applies transformation.
- or Esc cancels.

Info palette

- Click eyedropper icon to change color readout modes.
- Click cross-hair icon to change measurement units.

Common palette shortcuts

- Tab shows/hides all palettes, toolbox, shortcuts, and options bar.
- + Tab shows/hides all palettes except the toolbox, shortcuts, and options bar.

Undo History palette

- A. States of the image, from first to most recent;
 + Y steps forward;
 + Z steps backward;
 + + Z toggles current and last.
B. Drag slider moves selection between states.



Tool options bar

- | | |



Other Liquify Image shortcuts


-  + tool reverses direction for shift pixels and reflection tools.
-  in Brush Size and Pressure text box decreases/increases brush pressure by 1;  with Brush Size, Turbulent Jitter, and Pressure Slider showing decreases/increases brush pressure by 1; Hold down  decreases / increases brush size by 10x.
- [or] decreases or increases brush size.

Blending Mode

All the shortcuts are  +  + the letter.

Blending mode tool shortcuts

-  +  +  + D to desaturate.
-  +  +  + S to saturate.
-  +  +  + S to dodge/burn shadows.
-  +  +  + M to dodge/burn midtones.
-  +  +  + H to dodge/burn highlights.
-  +  + R to clear (Paint bucket tool only)
-  +  + Q to paint behind(Paintbrush tool only)



Layers palette

- A. Layer lock options (from left to right); Transparency, All;/ (forward slash) toggles lock transparency for target layer, or last applied lock.
- B. Links/unlinks to/from target layer.
- C. Indicates active paint layer.
- D. Shows/Hides layer;  + click shows this layer only/shows all layers.
- E. Double-click selects all type and temporarily selects type tool.
- F. Indentation indicates a grouped layer; icon points to the clipping layer.
- G.  + click thumbnail loads as selection;  +  + click thumbnail adds to current selection;  +  + click thumbnail subtracts from current selection;  +  + click intersects with current selection.
- H. Double-click to edit style settings options.
- I. Indicates New Fill or Adjustment layer.
- J.  + click toggles layer mask on/off; \ (backslash), or  +  + click toggles rubylith mode for layer mask on/off;  + click toggles layer mask and composite image.
- K.  + click groups/ungroups with/from previous layer.
