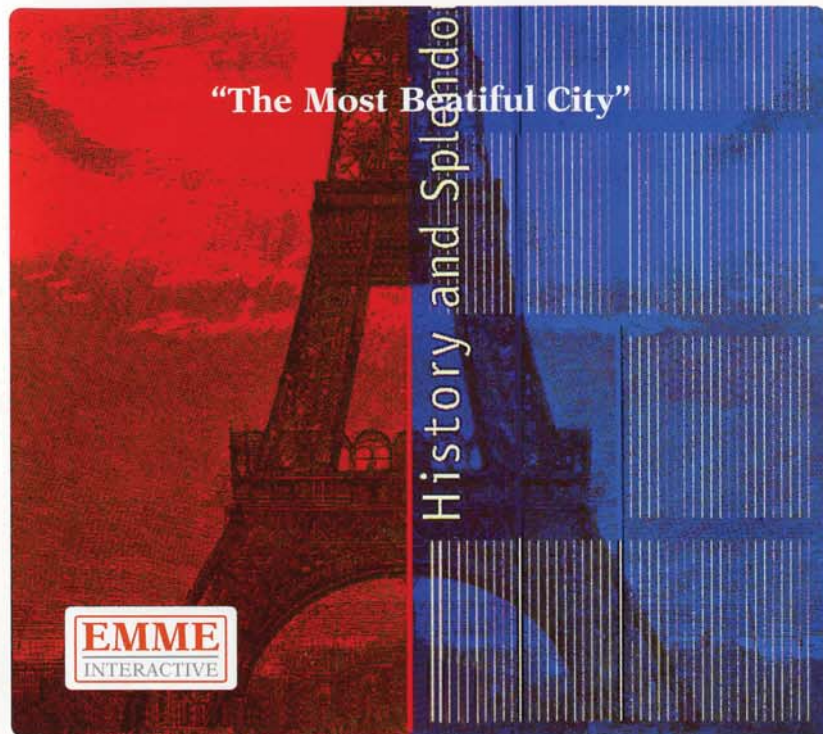

SETTING UP – WINDOWS

Once you have opened Windows™ with the FILE MANAGER, run the SETUP:EXE in the CD-ROM font.

For the audio you must activate the Video Player for Windows™ 1.1. If this has not been loaded, FILE MANAGER will let you run the SETUP:EXE in the CD-ROM RUNTIME branch. To hear the audio a Windows™ compatible audio file must be correctly installed.
